CLINICAL WASTE - CAN YOU HANDLE IT? With the implementation of the "Duty of Care" in April 1992, under the Environmental Protection Act 1990, responsibility has been placed on all those who create or handle waste to carry out its correct disposal. The Health Service Advisory Committee (HSAC) has issued guidelines for the safe disposal of clinical waste, and within those guidelines is a specific transport requirement for dedicated trucks, trolleys or wheeled containers to assist with the secure disposal of clinical waste.
